

7. The calendar year

All Audax UK events need to be published in at least one edition of *Arrivée* before they happen. This means that your event needs to be ready to be published approximately five months in advance. Table 1 lists deadlines for events in 2011 and 2012.

| If your event is on or later than... | ...it must appear in this edition of <i>Arrivée</i>... | ...so must be ready by... |

| 01 June 2012 | February 2012 | 07 January 2012 |

There is an additional deadline if you want to register an event with Les Randonneurs Mondiaux as a Brevet de Randonneur Mondial (BRM). This is necessary for any event that you want to count as a qualifier for Paris Brest Paris or many other international events over 600km. So, if you want to register a BRM event in 2012, then it needs to be ready by 18 September 2012.

When is an event 'ready'?

We mark events as ready when all the information we need is in place. In particular, we need the following completed:

- all controls listed with distances;
- route meets the minimum distance rule (see section 4, 'route')
- all information controls with fresh questions;
- completed risk assessment; and
- all contact information.
